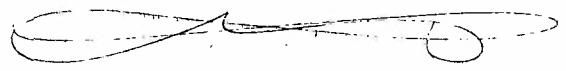

of the lands directed to be sold at *Zanesville* by the act of Congress; entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto the said *Abraham Holm*, the *half* lot or section of land above described: To have and to hold the said *Half* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Abraham Holm*, his heirs and assigns forever.

KNOW YE, That Abraham Holm, Assignee of Abraham Leezer, having deposited in the General Land Office a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Steubenville, whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the west half of Section ten in Township eleven north of Range eight west of the Ohio River Base and Meridian, Ohio, containing three hundred twenty-two acres and sixty hundredths of an acre of the lands directed to be sold at Steubenville, Ohio, by the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the Territory northwest of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky River," and of the Acts amendatory of the same, THERE IS GRANTED by the UNITED STATES, unto the said Abraham Holm, the Tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Abraham Holm and to his heirs and assigns forever.
