PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, THAT *Henry Hersheker, of York County, Pennsylvania,*
having deposited in the Treasury a Certificate of the Register of the Land
Office at *Steubenville* whereby it appears that *he has* — made
full payment for the *Lot or Section number Thirteen of Township*
number Eleven in Range number Eight, —
— of the Lands directed to be sold at *Steubenville* by the Act of
Congress, entitled, “An Act to amend the Act, entitled An Act pro-
viding for the sale of the Lands of the United States in the Territory
North West of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky River.”
THERE is granted by the United States in pursuance of the Act afore-
said, unto the said *Henry Hersheker* the —
— Lot or Section of Land above described. TO
HAVE and to HOLD the said — Lot or
Section of Land with the appurtenances unto the said *Henry Hersheker,*
— *his* heirs and assigns forever.
