PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, THAT Henry Wersheles of York County, Pennsylvania, having deposited in the Treasury a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Steubenville - whereby it appears that he has - made full payment for the Lot or Section number Fourteen of Township - number Eleven in Range number Eight, -

- of the Lands directed to be sold at Steubenville by the Act of Congress, entitled, "An Act to amend the Act, entitled An Act providing for the sale of the Lands of the United States in the Territory North West of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky River."

THERE is granted by the United States in pursuance of the Act afore-said, unto the said Henry Wersheles the -

- Lot or Section of Land above described. TO HAVE and to HOLD the said - Lot or Section of Land with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Wersheles - his heirs and assigns forever.
