Number Seven of Township Number Eleven, in Range Number Eight

— of the lands directed to be sold at *Steubenville* —
 by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United
 States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river,"
 and of the acts amendatory of the same, **There is granted, by the United States, unto**
 the said *Jacob Mishler* the ~~the~~ — — — — — lot or section —
 of land above described; **To have and to hold the said** — — — — — lot or

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That Jacob Mishler, having deposited in the Treasury, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Steubenville, whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the Section seven in Township eleven north of Range eight west of the Ohio River Base and Meridian, Ohio, containing six hundred thirty-seven acres and thirty-six hundredths of an acre of the lands directed to be sold at Steubenville, Ohio, by the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the Territory northwest of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky River," and of the Acts amendatory of the same, THERE IS GRANTED by the UNITED STATES, unto the said Jacob Mishler, the tract of land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Jacob Mishler and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is granted as and for a patent intended to have been granted and issued on February 20, 1810, but the issuance of which is not sufficiently evidenced by the records of the General Land Office or by other obtainable evidence.
