

**Wreaths Across America** – We were able to raise enough money from our November meeting raffle to provide the six Service Branch wreaths. The event takes place on December 16<sup>th</sup> at Henry Warstler Cemetery at noon. There is a short program and then the placing of wreaths by volunteers. *Virtual Gift Bags* – Several of our collections have grown this year and we need to take steps to preserve these items like we do the rest of our collection. These items require larger archival storage boxes and other supplies. So, this year we are offering virtual gift bags that you can sponsor to purchase the supplies needed to preserve an item(s) in our collection. We are focusing on our bible collection that went from about five bibles to over 20 this year and our textile collection. There are several bibles from early families like the McDowell, Pontius, and Wise families that have arrived this year. Our textile collection also has grown with the addition of two quilts, rag rugs, and hand embroidered items. So how does this work? 
