#### Wreaths Across America

We are not only donating the wreaths representing the different branches of the service, we are also assisting the Plain Township Fire Department and the Plain Township Rotary by verifying the veterans who are buried in Warstler Cemetery. Our "Walking" Warstler Cemetery group spent three Thursday's walking the whole cemetery identifying graves that were marked as Veterans. We then cross checked those graves to a spreadsheet that was created a few years ago. We are currently in the process of updating that spreadsheet, verifying people who were marked as Veterans but we do not have proof of service, and identifying Veterans that are not designated so on their headstone. The process will take some time. Our goal is to have the list completed by the 2026 Wreaths Across America event. Our next phase will be to mark headstones with a "Veteran" sticker which do not have any other identifying Veteran plaque or engraving. The wreath placing takes place on Saturday December 14<sup>th</sup> 2024 at noon, Warstler Cemetery.

#### PTHS is Going to Be 20 in 2025

In December 2024, we will be finalizing our plans for PTHS's 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration. Our organization has grown significantly during this period. We will be reflecting on our accomplishments in 2025. We have several things we are vetting right now to see if we can have them be a part of our celebration. As part of our 20<sup>th</sup> celebration, we will be the guest speaker for several organizations. The first one will be in December 2024 at the Avondale Neighborhood Christmas Party.
